2. Do you agree that the question "what must I do to be saved?" is the most important question a person could ask? Why or why not?

3. From the events in our study, how important is our response to situations even when we don't know that anyone is watching?

4. Read Acts 16:33-34. How important is it to follow up our queries with appropriate actions once the correct answers are received? Do you believe there are some persons who have asked the critical salvation question and yet remain lost?
