5. Summarize the lifestyle changes that Nehemiah instituted according to verses 16-23. How is that a model for us today (1 Peter 5:8-9)?
6. How is Nehemiah's dependence of God revealed in this chapter? What does our response to trouble reveal about our reliance on God?
