I. Getting to Know You

How did you experience God working in your life this week? How can we pray for you?

II. Digging Deeper

1. Do you agree the idea of the devil intensifying his attacks against us as we get closer to the finish line of a project? Discuss.
2. Observe the results of persistent pressure in Judges 14:15-17, and 16:15-17. How did Nehemiah protect himself from this fate in Nehemiah 6:1-4?
3. Nehemiah 6:9 (and 13) reveals a frequent weapon of the enemy. What is it? What is its result? How can we ward it off?

4. What would make the test in verses 10-14 more challenging than the previous two?

5. How do you think Nehemiah was able to discern that the advice was faulty? How can we protect ourselves from false spiritual teachers and teachings?

6. What truth from this week's study stood out to you most?
7. Can your life withstand attempted slander/defamation?
8. Are there unfinished "projects" in your spiritual life? Can you identify the tactic Satan has used to stall you? How can you overcome it?
