1 Peter 2:16
Live as people who are free,
not using your freedom as a
cover-up for evil, but living as
servants of God.

The only thing more dangerous than bondage is freedom!

We are not suggesting that bondage is good. We are simply acknowledging that freedom can be a volatile elixir if it is misunderstood or misapplied. In the verse before us, we are warned to handle freedom carefully. We are charged to recognize that freedom is not the right to do whatever we please, but the opportunity and responsibility to do what is good and noble.

If freedom is perceived as the right to do what-

ever we please, there is the potential for endless strife and dissipation. Strife results when our (real or perceived) rights conflict with another's (real or perceived) rights. How do we resolve this dispute? Unless someone is willing to curtail his freedoms, endless conflict can ensue resulting in great harm.

Perceiving freedom as the right to do whatever one pleases often leads to wasteful, self-harmful behaviors and attitudes. People who claim freedom to challenge established and natural norms needlessly flout guidelines which are designed to foster harmonious societal relationships. This reckless "freedom" acerbates the inevitable friction that attends interpersonal relationships and creates disorder and social chaos. Similarly, when individuals contradict the clear (unyielding) rules of nature in an attempt to bend the universe to their wishes or preferences, they experience irreconcilable inner conflicts which often lead to mental health issues and self-harm.

If, on the other hand, we recognize freedom as a crucial responsibility, we will carefully consider our options and choose the course which will produce the greatest good. We will train our minds with the truths of Scripture so that we can discern God's will in even the most challenging circumstances, and we will remain humble and open to correction as our understanding increases.

God wants us to be free..... truly free. He wants us to embrace Him and pursue His purposes on earth. He wants us to live full, virtuous lives. But we can only accomplish this by freely accepting His invitation to submit ourselves to His benevolent lordship. Have you accepted His invitation?
