3. Read 1 Corinthians 3:10-15. Is this speaking to believers? Discuss the principles outlined in this passage.

4. Scan Matthew chapters 5-7. Pick out 3 ways (there is a lot more than 3) a genuine walk with God impacts our everyday lives.

5. What truth from this week's study stood out to you most?

6. How deep is your relationship with Jesus? How is that depth reflected in your daily walk?

7. How is doing what Christ says a mark of genuine devotion to Him and not just following a set of rules?
