There are many circumstances in the way us and frighten us. Life doesn't go the way it should. We don't al-There are many circumstances that puzzle we expect or believe it should. We don't always know why things go wrong. We do what we believe to be right, yet we get unfavorable results. This reality can be maddening. But the ancient poet David discovered a remarkably

drum.

David decided to stop tormenting himself with the pursuit of complete understanding of life's ebbs and flows. He freely admits that he does not see the full picture – and never will. He concedes that there are some things too high for him. He recognizes that he will never be able to unravel all the mysteries of life. So instead, he focuses on one thing he can be absolutely sure of: God is absolutely trustworthy. And this trustworthy God is in control of his life and the universe. He uses this truth to calm his restless thoughts and rampant fears. He tells his soul to abandon the futile quest of knowing everything and to focus on knowing and believing one thing: God is faithful. The peace he discovers is like that of a fully satiated infant blissfully sleeping in its mother's

effective strategy for resolving this conun-tender arms completely unperturbed about life's struggles and challenges.

> David's strategy still works today. Instead of demanding to understand every circumstance and insisting that God owes us an explanation for every situation we face, we need to remind ourselves that our good God knows what He is doing and remains faithful to us. We can then humbly yield ourselves to Him, fully confident that we are safe in His care.

> May God give us the humility to trust Him so we can "sleep like a baby" despite life's challenges.
