MESSAGE FROM PASTOR



Ephesians 6:4 Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

There are many roles a father plays in his children's lives. He is provider, protector, hero, coach, and

confidante, to name a few. But his greatest role is to bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord. This is the most important role because it not only prepares the children to be good, decent people in this life, but also prepares them for eternity with God. How is the father to do this? It is important to note that the father must model genuine faith because his children will sniff out any counterfeit. A father, then, must cultivate an honest relationship with the Lord. He must trust Christ as his Savior and follow Him as his Lord. As the father enjoys this deep, personal relationship with Christ, his children will learn from observation and experience the difference Christ makes in a life. They will see that Christ makes life worthwhile and, God willing, want Him too.

So fathers, how are you doing with this great

responsibility? Do you feel inadequate to the task? Are you unsure about your biblical prowess? Focus on following Christ diligently yourself, and trust God to open the doors. God will give you the grace and the strength to live consistently as long as your heart is genuine before Him "For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to give strong support to those whose heart is blameless toward him," (2 Chronicles 16:9).
