MESSAGE FROM PASTOR

Resilient



*2 Corinthians 4:7
But we have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that the surpassing power belongs to God and not to us.*

With the simple phrase “but not,” Paul describes the amazing resilience of Christians. He writes in 2 Corinthians 4:8-9 “We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; 9 persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed” (emphasis added). While Christians can be afflicted, perplexed, persecuted, and struck down, they need not be overwhelmed. How can they withstand all that trauma? How can they survive – let alone thrive – in the midst of such awful circumstances? Paul revealed the secret before he even described the Christian’s resilience.

In verse 7 he writes: “But we have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that the surpassing power belongs to God and not to us.” Paul was speaking of the fact that God has done a work in the Christian’s heart through Jesus Christ. The light of God has shined into our hearts and transformed us (verse 6). This personal knowledge of Jesus Christ is a treasure with surpassing power. It was not the personal strength and fortitude of the believer that made him so resilient. Paul says that it was clear that the power was not of human origin, but from God. The secret of the Christian’s resilience is his relationship with Christ.

How resilient are you? (I’m really asking how much are you depending on the Lord in the daily cycles of life.) Our relationship to Jesus Christ unleashes power in us to face the crushing load of harsh circumstances and affliction with amazing resilience. We might bend, but we don’t break. We hurt, but we remain faithful. We live with hope and assurance. We find the strength in Christ to continue on the path He has laid out for us.

I’m not sure of all the circumstances you are facing, but I am fully confident that like Paul, we have this treasure in vessels of clay that produces surpassing power. May we, therefore, boldly proclaim in the face of our circumstances “but not [destroyed]!”
