5. In what ways are people today guilty of the same attitudes towards God that Paul describes in this passage?

6. What is your reaction to this statement: left to ourselves, we would only destroy ourselves?
7. How can we prevent ourselves from becoming rebellious toward God?
8. How does your knowledge of man's state apart from God affect your approach to evangelism?
