PROCLAIM RECONCILIATION

3. Why are the two aspects of exchange outlined in verses 19 (our sin not counted to our account) & 21 (Christ's righteousness counted to our account) necessary?

4. How should the idea of being Christ's ambassador affect our approach to sharing the gospel (verse 20)?

5. Do you think you've embraced your sacred trust of being an agent of gospel reconciliation? How does that affect your daily approach to life?
