*2 Corinthians 3:18  
And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.*

Referencing Moses’ experience, the Apostle Paul reveals in 2 Corinthians 3:18 that Christians today are similarly being transfigured – but on the inside. As we humbly and joyfully obey the Lord, may we experience the glorious inner transfiguration that is ours in Christ.
