UNFLINCHING RIGHTEOUSNESS

I. Getting to Know You

How did you experience God working in your life this week? How can we pray for you?

II. Digging Deeper

1. What do we understand from the concept of being "entrusted" with the Scriptures (verse 2)? How is that a privilege?
2. How is God being "judged" today (verse 4)? Do Christians judge God?
3. Is it ever acceptable (to God) for us to "do evil that good may come" (verse 8)? Why do we often behave this way? Suggest a better, Scriptural philosophy to live by.

4. How does Romans 3:1-8 highlight the glaring difference(s) between our righteousness and God's?

6. How will your knowledge of God's unflinching righteousness impact your lifestyle today and going forward?
