MESSAGE FROM PASTOR



*Psalm 102:25-27*  
*Of old you laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands. They will perish, but you will remain; they will all wear out like a garment. You will change them like a robe, and they will pass away, but you are the same, and your years have no end.*

The Psalmists contrasts the changelessness of God with the ever-changing natural world. Scientists tell us – and we can observe for ourselves – that the earth

is wearing out. Land is constantly being eroded into the seas. Vegetation is removed for buildings and industries. Some animal species are under threat of extinction. The Bible predicted these realities long ago - and tells us there will be one cataclysmic day when the Lord will destroy this old sinful earth and create a new one (2 Peter 3:10-13).

Yet God Himself does not change.

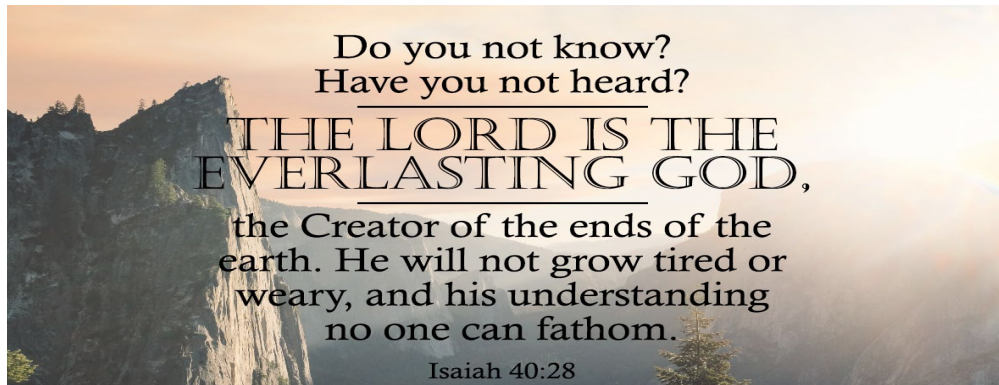
