3. What "work" does God want us to do (verses 28-29)? Note the shift from plural to singular between the question and Christ's answer. How important is that?

4. List two or three hang-ups that made it hard for the crowd to accept Christ as the Bread of God.

5. Why did Peter and the other disciples stay with Christ according to verses 68-69?

6. Judas was around Christ but never yielded to Him, and suffered disastrous consequences. How can we be guilty of the same behavior today?
7. List some steps can we take to prevent challenging situations from pulling us away from Christ?
8. What stood out most to you this week?
