2. What does the woman's response in verses 16-17 reveal about not just her, but people in general?
3. This woman had had five failed marriages, yet she was in another (illicit) relationship. What do you think she was trying to find? What are we searching for?

4. What do you think is meant by worshiping God in "spirit and truth" in verse 24?

5. Jesus promised that whoever drank His living water would never thirst again (verse 14), yet some Christians still feel like their lives are unfulfilled. Why do you think they feel this way?

6. What are some ways people try to fill their lives apart from Christ? Are you guilty of any of these? What will you change?
7. Consider the significance of the woman abandoning her waterpot in verse 28. What does that tell us about how our focus changes if we truly find Christ?
8. What stood out most to you this week?
