1. Scan Joshua 23 and list the two promises God made to Israel (note the verses they are found in too). Were the promises fulfilled?
2. According to Joshua 23:6-8, what steps were the people to take in order to continue to “possess” the land? What can we glean from this passage about what it means to “possess the land”?

3. What is the secret of winning battles according to Joshua 23:9-10? How can we experience that in our own lives today?
4. Read 1 Peter 1:3-11. What are the promises God has made to us (4, 8, 10,11). What do we need to do to actualize these promises?

5. In Joshua 23:14, Joshua affirms that the people know that God has been completely faithful to them. Would you concur with that same truth when you look over your life? Are there specific instances you can name that show God's faithfulness? How will this reality affect your life going forward?
