3. Why is an intellectual understanding of Christianity so important to discipleship (Matthew 28:20, Matthew 22:29)?

4. Why are so many Christians limited in our knowledge of the Scriptures? How would you rate your knowledge of the Bible? How can we (you) improve it?

5. Using James 1:22-25. discuss the importance of a practical understanding of Scripture (Matthew 28: 19 "to observe").

6. In light of Jesus command in Matthew 28:20 to "observe *all*" that He has commanded us, why are some many Christians content to pick and choose what we want to practice? How can we correct this error?
